

The Society, through its website, maintains a database of over 115,000 burials in over 280 cemeteries located in Dauphin County, Pennsylvania. This database is completely searchable by name and cemetery. This is an invaluable resource for those doing research in the Harrisburg and Dauphin County areas. In addition the Society maintains a number of printed cemetery listings in its Research Library.

Research Library

The library is open from 1:15 p.m. until the start of the meeting at 2:30 p.m. If there is interest, the library will re-open following the meeting and speaker's presentation and will stay open during the social hour.
